### What would you like to accomplish during your first year?

I will make use of all of my experience and skills as a librarian to make a great impact. I've worked as a Teen Librarian, in Adult Services as a Reference Librarian, and as a library Technology Specialist twice. #### What is your favorite book?

I'm proud of the work that I've done as a librarian--especially when being my most creative, and feeling like I've succeeded at it. I feel great and in my element when doing teen programs. I also enjoy writing articles for libraries and solving critical tech issues.

#### From the Archives:


#### July 27, 1874 – June 5, 1940

F. Luis Mora was considered the first Hispanic Master painter. His father, Domingo Mora, immigrated from Uruguay to Perth Amboy as a talented sculptor. Domingo was the chief designer for the Perth Amboy Terra Cotta Co. There, he designed architectural sculptures for hundreds of buildings, including New York City's Metropolitan Opera House. F. Luis Mora's paintings are currently held or on display in 34 museums, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York (8) and the Smithsonian American Art Museum. Mora's works are also held by The Butler Museum of Art in Ohio, The Newark Museum, The Telfair Museum in Savannah, The New York Historical Society, The Museum of the City of New York, the Toledo Museum of Art, Yale University Art Gallery, The National Gallery of Canada in Ottawa, National Arts Club in New York. Phoenix Art Museum, The National Academy of Design in New York, San Diego Museum of Art, and many others.

#### Family relationships:

Mora's mother was Laura Gaillard, a cultured French woman originally from the Bordeaux region of France. Laura Gaillard Mora had two sisters, Ernestina and Gabriella, who married into the Bacardi family, famous for its rum.


F. Luis Mora was married for 31 years to Sophia ("Sonia") Brown Compton Mora, daughter of Perth Amboy's Mayor Compton. They had one daughter, Rosemary, who never married and never had children; and therefore, Mora's direct lineage ended with her.....Wikipedia

At the Perth Amboy Free Public Library, we offer library cards for even the youngest members of our community. If you have a baby living in Perth Amboy, they can get a library card right from birth. And it's not just for the little ones – we also make library cards for teenagers and adults in our Children's Room.

We understand that parenting can be a handful, and toddlers can have their moments, but rest assured, we won't ask parents or guardians to leave.

For added convenience, our downstairs restroom is equipped with a changing table, making it easier for patrons with babies.

Our Children's Room is a fantastic space for kids up to 7th grade. It offers a wide range of resources to cater to different ages and interests. For the youngest ones, we have board books and materials for babies and toddlers. Older kids who are advanced readers can explore some teen novels in our fiction collection.

We also have a dedicated section for Spanish language materials, suitable for all ages up to 7th grade. In addition to our collection, we provide working computers for kids and offer a selection of audio books that patrons can listen to. If you need headphones, they are available at the front desk.

And don't forget, teens and adults are always welcome to use the Children's Room at any time. It's a versatile and inclusive space for the whole family to enjoy.




